

# Key Events to Remember

(Mark 14-15)

There are two key events in today's message that we are told to \_\_\_\_\_ and interestingly enough they are directly related to one another...

1- Remember—do all that is in your power for the Lord – Mark 14:1-9

- That good part is \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ and his words – Lk. 10:38-42; Jo. 12:1-7

It comes as the result of a deep \_\_\_\_\_ for Christ and the Bible

It includes brokenness—giving something of great value for Christ – verse 3

This type of sacrificial love for Christ is considered an irritating waste by devilish people – verses 4-5

Today we \_\_\_\_\_ that *she hath done what she could* for Christ – verse 8

- The last supper and betrayal – Mark 14:10-11, 43-45, 12-21

The lost world is a living betrayal of Christ

In contrast, as believers we must \_\_\_\_\_ to do all that is in our power for the Lord

2- Remember—he died for us and will come again to set all things right – Mark 15:1-39

- The ordinance is:

Eat the bread and drink the cup to remember his death until he comes again – 1 Cor. 11:23-26

Do it earnestly, examining ourselves, judging our own sins – 1 Cor. 11:27-32
