		- A GOOD WORK AND ITS CALLING – 1 TIMOTHY 3:1  A bishop is both an office and a calling – it is synonymous with the title Elder, Shepherd, or				
		- CHARACTER QUALITIES FOR ALL PASTORS — 1 TIMOTHY 3:2-7 While no pastor can achieve these perfectly — he is to exemplify his faith by manifesting these qualities				
		- CHARACTER QUALITIES FOR ALL BELIEVERS — 1 TIMOTHY 3:2-13  Because pastors, deacons, and their wives are called from within the body of believers in a local church these character qualities apply to man and woman
