	All your mind – your thoughts, plans, decisions, and logic prove your love All your strength – your fervor in duty, labor and service demonstrates your love
b. N	Jumber 2 greatest commandment
-	Thou shalt thy neighbor as thyself – verse 39 As you love yourself
-	This type of love is best described as – 1 Cor. 13; Lk. 10:25-37
-	The greatest love we can show to others – Jo. 13:34-35; 15:7-17  Love them without setting any conditions for them to meet  Tell them about the love and saving power of Jesus Christ  Help them grow and mature to be a man or woman that pleases God  Encourage and admonish them to have faith in the words of God  Always seek to be a godly example to follow
