We live in a time that is prophesied as having increased knowledge which is readily attainable (Dn. 12:4). The fulfillment of this happening before our very eyes raises two important questions every Bible believer needs to answer. First, an increase of the knowledge of what exactly (Ecc. 1:18; I Tim. 6:20-21)? Second, is such easy knowledge actually (Jn. 18:38)? Much of the information we attain is in things that are ungodly or that don't matter and therefore comes as a distraction (I Cor. 8:1; II Tim. 3:7). So much so that the church is being distracted right out of a relationship with Jesus Christ (I Cor. 7:35).			
Your source of truth will become your source of, either giving you joy or robbing it from you (Jer. 4:22; Rm. 16:19). It is time to get back what really matters (Jn. 17:17), an intimate relationship that comes through a deep,, personal pursuit of the excellency of the knowledge of Jesus Christ our Lord (Ps. 42:7; Phil. 4:8-9).
