

## APPROVED UNTO GOD – 2 TIMOTHY 2:15

In today's text we will examine \_\_\_\_\_\_ and valuable *final* instructions given by the apostle Paul to the young pastor and missionary, Timothy. These truths are for \_\_\_\_\_\_ believer and can change the way you think and act as a Christian if they are adopted and applied.

- 1. The text 1 Timothy 2:15
  - a. Key points
    - What to do with the Bible: We are to \_\_\_\_\_ the Bible
    - Why we must study the Bible:

To be \_\_\_\_\_\_ unto God

To not be \_\_\_\_\_\_ before God

- *How* we must study the Bible:

Rightly \_\_\_\_\_\_ the *word of truth* (the completed revelation of scripture— all 66 books of the Bible)

- b. Attitude and posture while studying:
  - That of a \_\_\_\_\_\_ 2 Timothy 2:2-7
- 2. Fulfilling the key points
  - a. Any \_\_\_\_\_\_ can understand the Bible
    - The Bible is an open book
      - It is not difficult to understand
      - Anyone can get a working knowledge of the Bible if they are willing to do the work

Beware of the doctrine of the Nicolaitans (Nico-to *conquer*; laitans - *laity*) – Rev. 2:6, 15

The main reason most Christians have no logical understanding of *how to study the Bible* is: their pastors and leaders do \_\_\_\_\_\_ understand how to study the Bible... they teach what they read in a book or commentary, heard from a podcast or recording, watched on YouTube, or by following their [pastoral] peer groups

- b. Basic principles of learning and understanding the Bible
  - You learn by following rule #1: \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Book
  - You learn as the Holy Spirt \_\_\_\_\_\_ and guides you John 14:16-17, 26; 16:13-14
  - You learn by avoiding the hazards of Bible study
    #1 threat: The search for hidden meanings
    #2 threat: Refusal to see beyond the literal historic and grammatic meaning
    #3 threat: A personal desire to be the authority
  - You learn by receiving God's purpose of scripture 2 Timothy 3:15-17
    - A copy of the originals is also considered inspired by God
    - By knowing the four profitable purposes of scripture: doctrine, reproof, correction, instruction in righteousness...
    - God's overall objective for scripture in each believer: throughly furnished unto all good works
  - You learn by studying the \_\_\_\_\_ English Bible
  - You learn by following the basic rules and proven biblical methods of Bible study (referred to as *Hermeneutics* in Bible Colleges and circles of higher education)
