	- The Bible is no ordinary book		
	The Bible has a total of 66 books, written by more than 40 authors over a time span of about 2,000 years, yet it fits together perfectly as if written by one man, having one main, testifying of its inspiration from the Holy Ghost		
	The Bible is totally accurate in matters of history and prophecy and contains no provable errors or contradictions		
	The Bible contains OT events, narratives, and records that are foreshadows, types, and similitudes matching NT truths that cannot be explained by human rationale		
	The Bible has OT doctrinal found within the order of books, chapters, and even passages that match NT truths that cannot be explained by human rationale
