2-	A lamb is required – Exodus 12:3-10
	- Every house needs lamb – verse 3
	- Not just <i>a</i> lamb will do, it must be lamb – verse 4
	- A lamb must be the lamb and ultimately it must become lamb – verse 5
	- The lamb was to be killed in the – verse 6
	- The lamb's blood be applied to the doorposts – verse 7
	- The lamb must be consumed – verses 8-10 It must be roasted with It must be eaten with unleavened bread and bitter herbs It must be completely consumed This is a work
3-	The manner in which the lamb was eaten – Exodus 12:11-12
	- Urgency is necessary – verse 11
	- Be fully, judgment is coming – verse 12
4-	There is only way to escape judgment – Exodus 12:13 - Salvation is through the blood of the spotless lamb – Jesus Christ is the only way
5-	The Jewish Passover and the Church's Communion are similar – Exodus 12:14
