THE MILLENNIAL KINGDOM – Revelation 20:1-6

The Millennial kingdom is the literal fulfillment of every message from God's prophets since the world began, and this is the _____ of the entire Bible (Acts 3:19-23). The battle over the throne and who will sit on that throne is finally over: The world has been taken over by force by the physical return of the Lord Jesus Christ (Rev. 19:11-21), the devil is supernaturally bound by a chain in the bottomless pit (Rev. 20:1-3), the Lord Jesus Christ will rule and reign over the whole world and universe from a literal throne in Jerusalem (Jer. 23:5-6; Lk. 1:30-33), sinless/glorified kings and priests (the church) and martyred tribulation saints will assist the governance of the Lord's kingdom (Rev. 20:4-6), and the remaining and resurrected Israel will participate in their promised kingdom under the leadership of their Messiah (Zech. 12:10-14; Matt. 8:11). God's promise of peace has finally come!

- d. The kingdom and its people (Jew and Gentile) will be governed by the constitution of the kingdom – Is. 2:1-5; Matt. 5-7
- e. The Jewish feast of _____ will be reestablished – Zech. 14:16-17
- f. The 12 apostles and church age saints will rule as kings and priests with Christ, along with the Tribulation saints – Matt. 19:28; 1 Cor. 6:2-3; Rev. 1:5-6; 2:26-28; 5:9-10; 20:4-6; Luke 19:11-27
- g. Nature is regenerated, the animal kingdom is under dominion, and all is in a state of _____ – Is. 35:1-2; 11:6-9; Ezek. 36:33-36; Rom. 8:19-21

- a. To _____ and honour the King of kings and Lord of lords, Jesus Christ – Matt. 3:17; 17:5; 25:31; Jn. 5:23; Ps. 24; 1 Cor. 15:28

- b. To fulfill God's promise to Israel – Gen. 12:1-3, 7; 13:14-18; 17:1-8; Matt. 19:28; 25:34

- c. To display a perfect and holy kingdom – Is. 9:6-7; 11:1-5 (Jn. 7:24); Ps. 67:4

- d. To reward church age saints – Rom. 8:17; Col. 3:23-24; Eph. 5:5; Lk. 19:11-27

- e. To give creation a _____ – Lev. 25:2-7; Gen. 2:1-3; Is. 14:7; Heb. 4:6-9

- f. To reveal the enemy of the sinful flesh and its power – Rom. 7:18; Jas. 1:14; Ps. 39:5
