	а.	Philadelphia is an inland city of ancient Lydia (modern day Turkey) located approximately 125 miles from the coast of the Aegean Sea. It had a natural fortress aspect because of its geographic location, yet it was susceptible to earthquakes and other negative environmental forces.
	b.	The Greek culture totally dominated the area—it was called "little Athens" and was populated primarily by middle class people.
		- The church in Philadelphia was very fruitful and accomplished much in the way of evangelism and church planting in spite of the limited resources they possessed.

		e Philadelphia Church Period begins with the close of the Dark Ages and ends at the conclusion of e 19 th Century—the time known as the "Modern Industrial Age."
	a.	During the Philadelphia Church Period the Bible is back in the hands of the common man (Mk. 12:37). With the invention of the printing press all men could eventually obtain a personal copy of God's completed word.
	b.	The church of the Philadelphian period possesses the <i>Key of David</i> . And as a result, they have an <i>open door</i> to the world because God said they <i>kept my word And hast not denied my name</i>

- During the Philadelphian church period there are seven main English translations leading up to the *key* that launched the greatest period in church history:

The Philadelphian church period is the "golden age" of missions and missionary work. It is the

greatest time of world evangelism the planet has ever known.

Psalm 12:6-7 – The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified <u>seven</u> times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt <u>preserve</u> them from this generation for ever. (Emphasis added)

	- Ultimately, America too traded in her English Bible, the Bible that stirred our American founding Fathers to freedom, the Bible that launched the Philadelphian Church Period.
	- The Revised Version of 1881 in England gave rise to the American Standard Version of 1901 these Bibles were not "revisions" of the KJV but were in fact completely
	Bibles, translated from the corrupt texts of the Roman Catholic Church, traced all the way back to Alexandria, Egypt (Africa) and the false teacher, the demonic kingpin of all corrupt Bibles, the pseudo-Christian, Adamantius Origen.
