Today our study concerning the dreadful details of the <i>great tribulation</i> continues. Last week in part we learned of the first four trumpet judgments (also called <i>plagues</i> – Rev. 9:20; 11:6) that focuse the desolation of the:

a. The fifth trumpet sounds – verses 1-12	
- Plague:	
Satanic scorpion-like are freed from a bottomless pit to torture mankind Num. 16:30; ls. 14:9, 15; Ezek. 32:27; Lk. 16:19-26; Mt. 12:40; Eph. 4:8-9	_

A comparison of locusts:	
Natural locusts Attack vegetation Subdued by smoke Can be exterminated Have no stinger Have no king (Pr. 30:27) Supernatural locust of Revelation 9 Attack men Arise out of smoke Are invincible Sting like a scorpion A king directs them; they too have, as it were, crowns	

Who is their king?

He is conceivably the first horsemen (or grim reaper) of Chapter 6

He has a Hebrew name: Abaddon He has a Greek name: Apollyon

- Result:

They attack men, but not all men
They torment men but do not kill them
They torment mankind for 5 months
